In attendance: Chairman High, Trustee Reading, Trustee Robinson, HOS Vickie McCullough, Jared Dawson from the Idaho Public Charter Commission. Trustee Reading made a motion to approve the April Agenda. Trustee Robinson gave a second and the motion passed. Trustee Robinson made a motion to approve the prior meeting minutes. Trustee Reading gave a second and the motion passed.
11:35	Public Comment	Discussion	Board Chair	No members of the public were present outside of Jared Dawson from the Idaho Public Charter Commission. He stated that he was there as part of the renewal process to simply observe a board meeting per the process.
11:40	State of the School	Discussion	Vickie McCullough	The HOS began by sharing demographic data about the students. At the time of the meeting 301 students were enrolled with 60% of the student classified as at risk. ICON continues to draw from large Treasure Valley Areas with Boise, Meridian, Nampa, and Caldwell as the highest population sites. We also have a strong presence in the Magic Valley area. We currently have 22 students enrolled in our Homeschool Program. ICON has also just opened their 10 th treatment center. The HOS also shared that the fall semester data demonstrated an increase in credit attempted vs. credits earned and the highest level in our at risk population ever. 92% of the general population credits were passed while 85% of the at risk population credits were passed. This

				is up from our baseline data of 66.9% and 43.3%. The HOS discussed the fact that the mastery model and the mastery-based understanding process were fully implemented and showing positive results in teaching students skills and application. Trustee Reading commended the school on how far we have come since our baseline data of 2014.
12:15	Charter Renewal	Discussion/Action	Vickie McCullough	Chairman High shared with the board that the Idaho Public Charter Commission had sent a courtesy letter to the board concerned about the number of meetings that that board had during the year. Chairman High responded to the Commission stating that ICON did recognize the need for more consistent board meetings and laid out not only the next three meetings for the year but laid out a general plan for meetings for the 26/27 school year. The Commission was pleased with the response. Jared Dawson was there as part of the renewal process to observe a board meeting. He briefly shared that in the upcoming weeks ICON would meet with the Commission to walk through the renewal process to outline what to expect. HOS McCullough shared how instrumental both Mr. Dawson and the Commission had been to the school over the past year.
